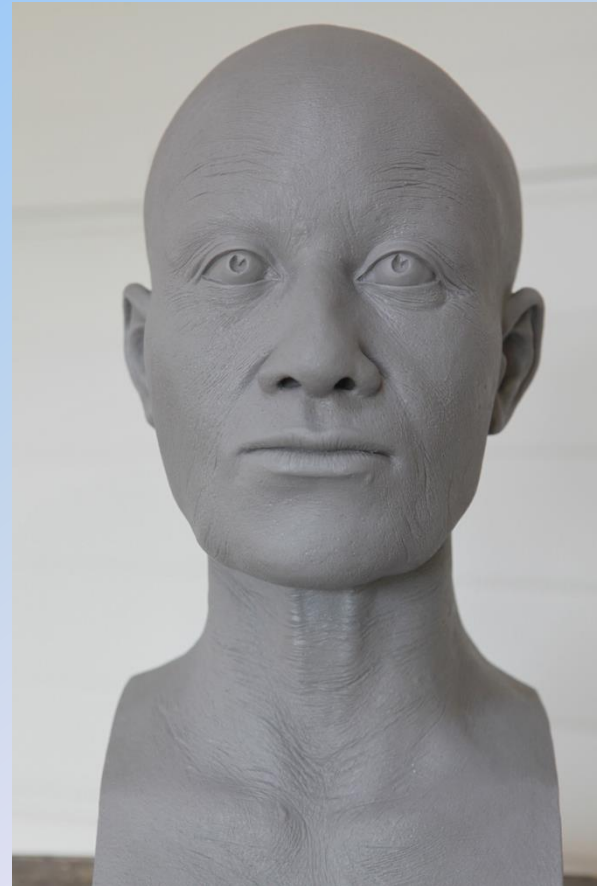


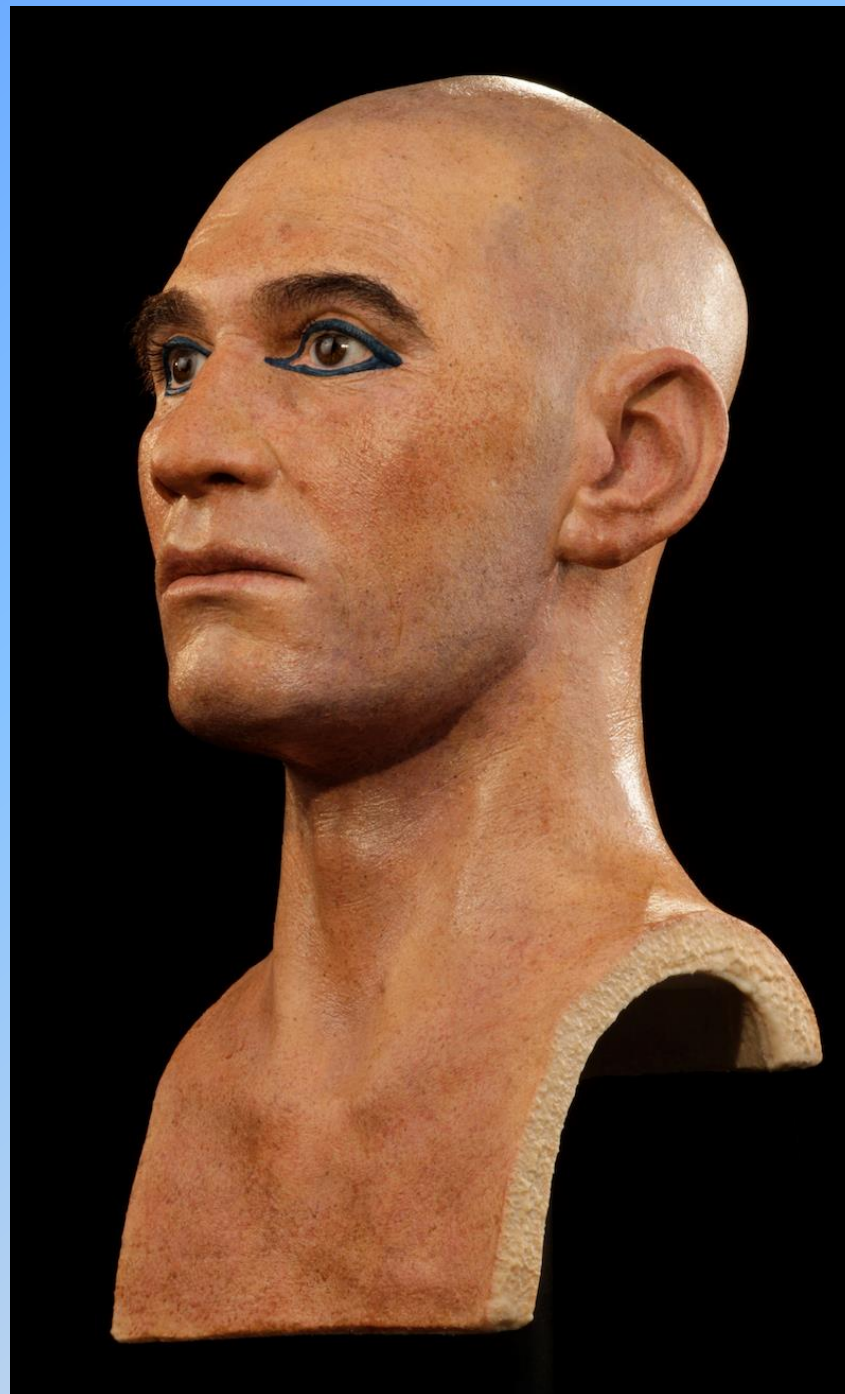












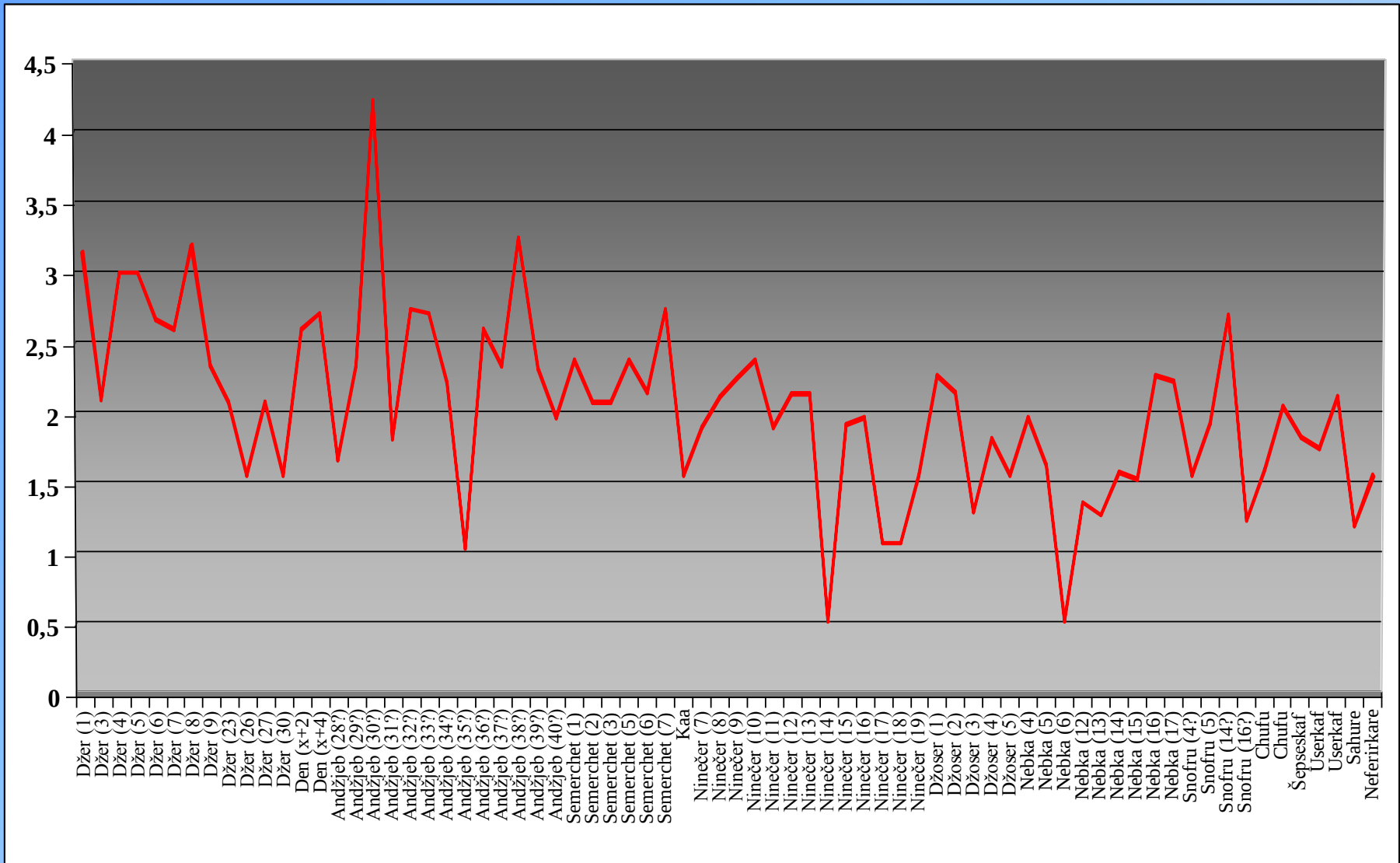


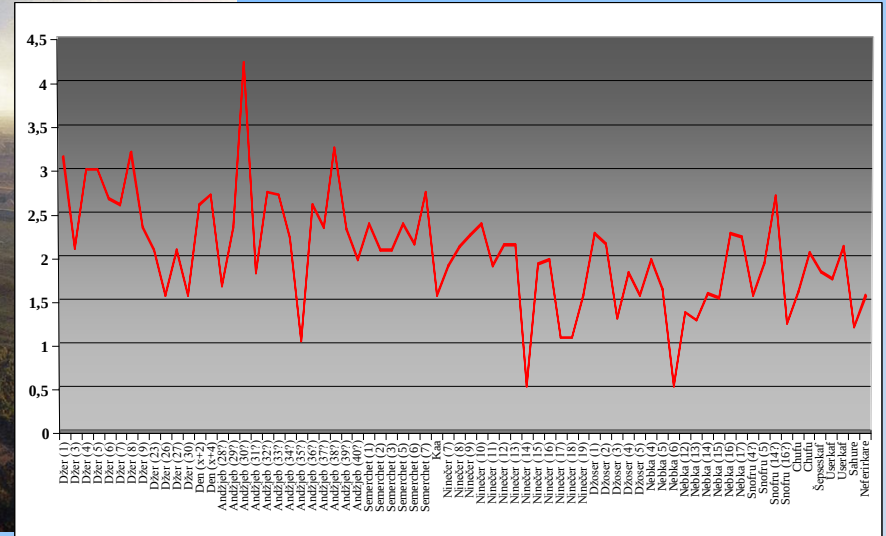
Reign of Nyuserra: topicalisation of the desert in around 2400 BC

Lion (*Panthera Leo*), wild bull (*Bos africanus* Brehm), hartebeest (*Alcelaphus buselaphus*), Isabela-gazelle (*Gazela Isabella* Gray), oryx antelope (*Oryx algazel dammah*), addax (*Addax nasomaculata* Blainville), dorcas gazelle (*Gazella dorcas*), capricorn (*Capra nubiana* F. Cuvier), barbary sheep (*Ammotragus lervia* Pallas), hyena (*Hyaena hyaena* L.), wild dog (*Canis lupaster* Hemprich a. Ehrenberg), hunt dog (*Canis lupaster domesticus*), hare (*Lepus aegyptius* Demarest), Saharan striped polecat (*Ictonyx libyca* Ehrenberg), desert jerboa (*Jaculus jaculus* L.), fennec fox (*Vulpes zerda*) and hedgehog (*Erinaceus auritus* Pallas).
